AUGUST 03

PRIMARY ELECTION

Local elections are nonpartisan, which means there's only a primary if three candidates run for an office. So, there might not be a primary in your county. If there is, we'll send you a timeline and resources to mobilize your voters.

TODAY

REGISTER AS AN AMBASSADOR

Once you're in, add (at least) ten friends to your contact list that you will help vote this year. Then, come to one of our weekly Ambassador trainings starting June 01! You can do this anytime, but why not get it done while you're thinking about it?!

SEPTEMBER 19

AMBASSADOR KICK OFF

Join us for our official kick-off. Hear our plan for 2021, meet other team leaders, and get all the new resources.

SEPT. 08 - OCT. 10

GET YOUR FRIENDS REGISTERED

Encourage everyone on your list to visit KSVotes.org to check their registration status - or register online - and sign up to vote by mail without printing or scanning any documents. 98% of the people we talked to in 2020 who got a mail-in ballot actually turned it in! You could also do this any time after June 1.

OCTOBER 12

KANSAS REGISTRATION DEADLINE

Last chance to make sure your friends are registered!

OCT. 11 - OCT. 17

BALLOT FDUCATION

Help your friends know who and what is on their ballot by sending them to KSBallot.org, a nonpartisan site that lists everyone they'll be voting for, with links to candidates' positions and social media. They can also find their polling location here. KSBallot.org will be live in September, but it makes sense to wait until people are starting to pay more attention.

OCTOBER 18 - 29

ENCOURAGE EARLY VOTING

Follow up to make sure they turn in that ballot. Check on your friends voting by mail and make sure they got their ballots, feel comfortable filling them out, and have a stamp! For everyone else, encourage them to vote early. You can vote early, in person after October 14, although the dates will vary by county. Times are locations are available at KSBallot.org

OCT. 30 - NOV. 2

GET OUT THE VOTE!

Touch base with each friend in the last four days to make sure they have a plan to vote. If your friends haven't voted yet, you'll need to get them there on Election Day. Take that extra step and ask specific questions about their plan (how, where, what time), then follow-up and make sure they got it done! EDay is November 2! This is crunch time!

NOVEMBER 03: ELECTION DAY!

Make sure your election day voters are still on track to cast their ballot.

Once everyone gets it done, kick back with your favorite drink and congratulate yourself on being awesome.
