DON'T SIT OUT YOUR LOCAL ELECTIONS!

This year we're **ELECTING OUR LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS, CITY COUNCILS,** and in some cases, **MAYORS.**

FEWER PEOPLE SHOW UP IN LOCAL ELECTIONS!

In Kansas the turnout is around **20%**, and these races are **often won or lost by just a couple of votes.**
This means **YOUR** vote has extra weight.

GET READY TO VOTE IN KANSAS

1. Make *sure* you're registered to vote.

Check your existing registration, re-register if you've moved recently, or register to vote for the first time! Do it online **before the October 17 deadline** at [KSVotes.org](https://www.KSVotes.org).

2. Get ready to vote early.

It's free, easy, and safe to vote by mail in Kansas! Fill out an online request for an advance ballot at [KSVotes.org](https://www.KSVotes.org).

3. Be an informed voter.

Head over to [KSBallot.org](https://www.KSBallot.org) to learn what races are on your ballot, research your candidates, and make a plan to vote early or on Election day.



4. VOTE!

ADVANCE BALLOT? YOU HAVE THREE OPTIONS:

Mail it back

Take it to a drop box location.
Find them at [KSBallot.org](https://www.KSBallot.org).

Take it to a polling location,
either early or on election day. Find these locations at [KSBallot.org](https://www.KSBallot.org).

IN PERSON, EARLY? Want to vote before election day in person? Early voting locations will be **open by October 18** in many places. Check for locations and dates at [KSBallot.org](https://www.KSBallot.org).

ON ELECTION DAY? Want to vote on the day itself? Polls are open **November 7** until **7pm**. Find out where your polling location is at [KSBallot.org](https://www.KSBallot.org).
