VOTE WHERE YOU ARE

Our first choice - and the easiest for you! Register at your campus address at KSVotes.org by Oct 13 for the General!

#2

VOTE FROM HOME COUNTY

The next best option, and you're probably registered there anyway. If you go this route, we'd suggest voting by mail, or you'll have to get back home to vote in-person. Request your ballot at KSVotes.org

#3

VOTE FROM OUT OF STATE

Our least fave option and most difficult. Stay registered in another state and make sure you know how to vote back home (google your Secretary of State's rules)

VOTE IN HOME COUNTY

Good idea. Apply for a mail ballot on [KSVotes.org](https://ksvotes.org) and have it mailed to your campus address.

When you get it, mail it back right away - like, the same day. Mail ballots must be postmarked by Election Day.*
